ARC Weekend Program Calendar 2017

The ARC 2017-18 program will be held from September 7, 2017 until May 24, 2018. The program runs most Friday evenings from 6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. and on Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

A period of six weeks (30 days) of full-time student practicum are required which is scheduled from March through May.

October 2, 2017	Fingerprinting deadline.**
March 26, 2018 to May 7, 2018	Full-time student practicum (30 days).
May 8, 2018 to May 18, 2018	Student practicum make-up time.

* These dates may be subject to change.

** Fingerprinting and background checks completed by RESC after **July 1, 2017** are acceptable for students who were previously fingerprinted for K-12 employment. The student can provide ARC with any official verification of fingerprinting and background check information already on file with a participating RESC.

2017-18 Program Costs

A non-refundable application fee of \$125 must accompany the completed application. If a student is reapplying to the program, there is a \$100 fee to reactivate an existing file.

Tuition is \$5,000.00 for the program. A non-refundable deposit of one-third (1/3) of the tuition, \$1,650.00, is due upon acceptance into the program. The balance of the tuition and fees is due before the mandatory ARC orientation. If the program does not run due to low enrollment, all monies paid will be refunded.

A \$500 Technology Fee will be assessed to each admitted student.

Textbooks and other supplies average \$300 to \$500 depending on content subject area.

Student Practicum: The cost of student practicum is included in the tuition for the program. If a student fails the student practicum, then the cost to repeat it will be charged to the student. **The cost to repeat the student practicum is \$800** and will be due before arrangements will be made for the placement.
